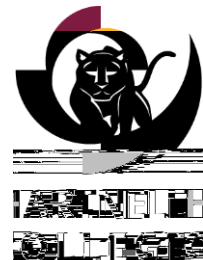

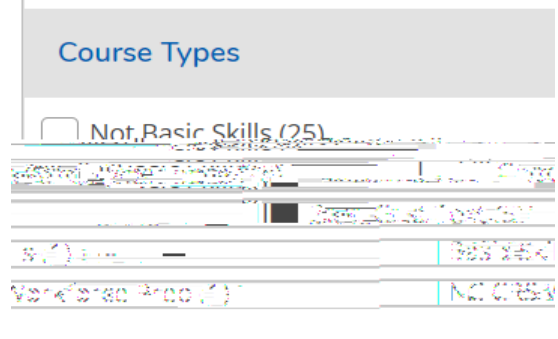

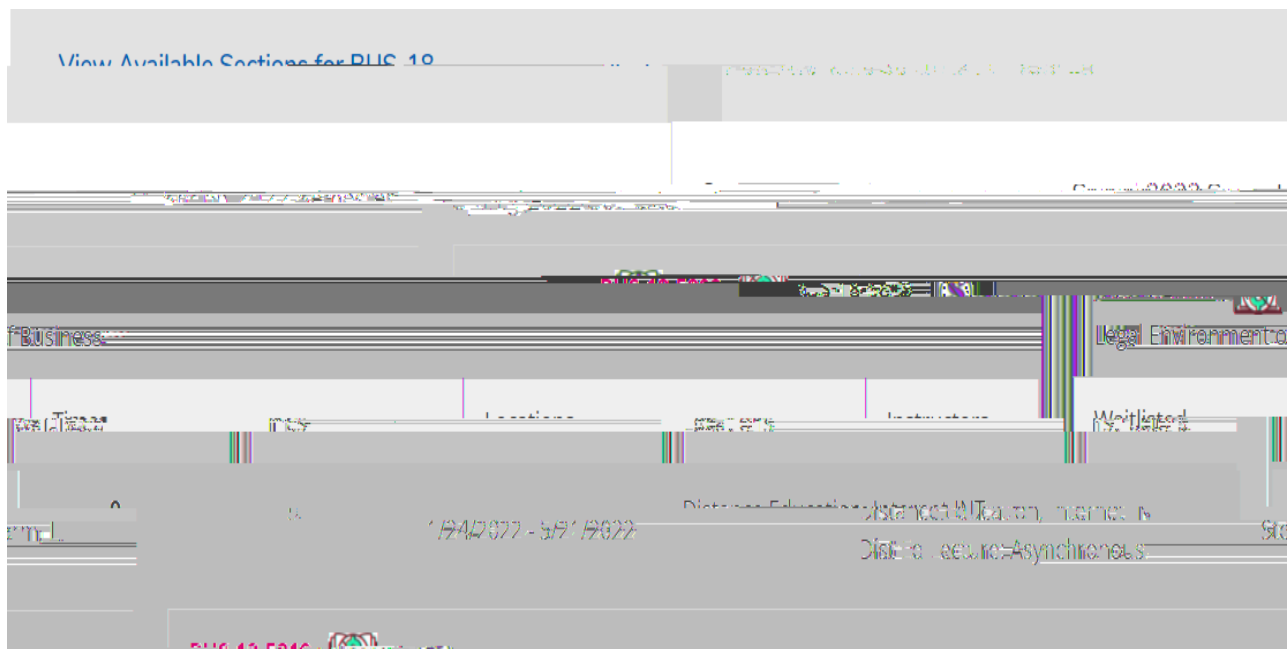




Current situation with PAWS self-service and ZTC sections:

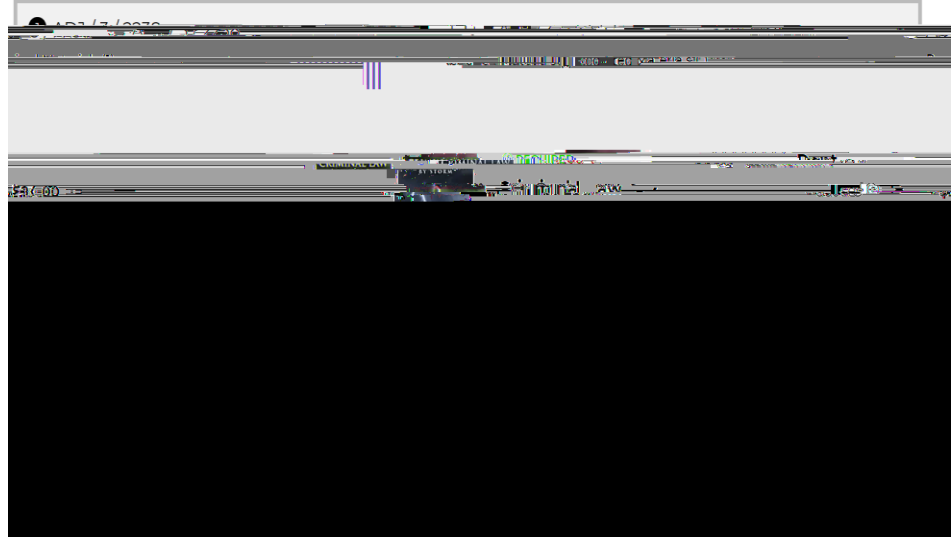
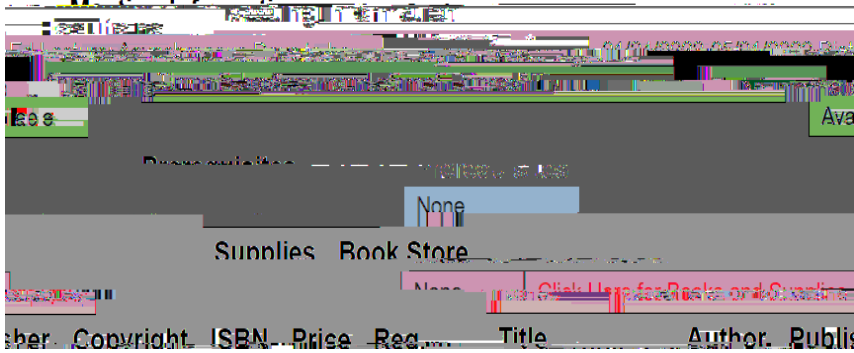
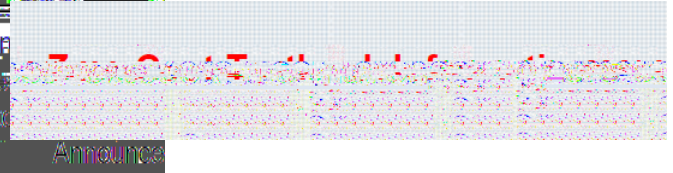
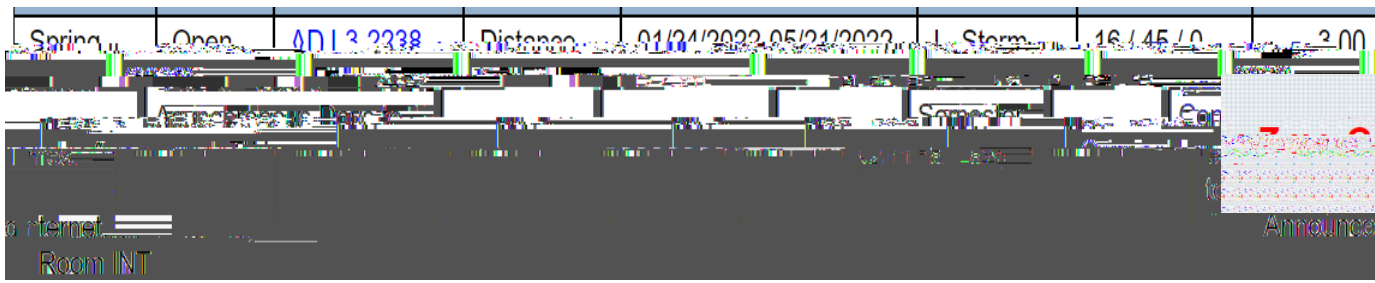

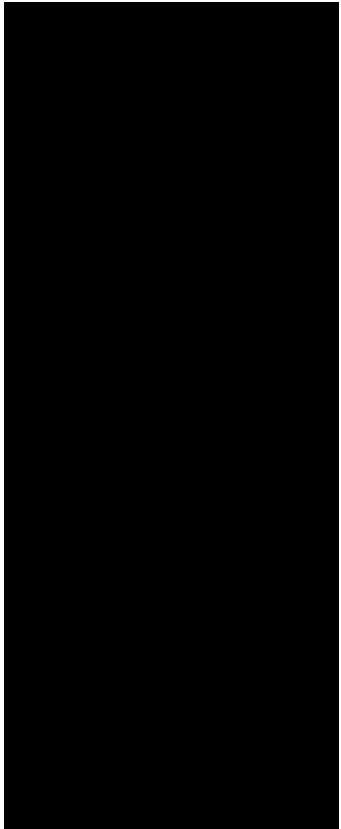
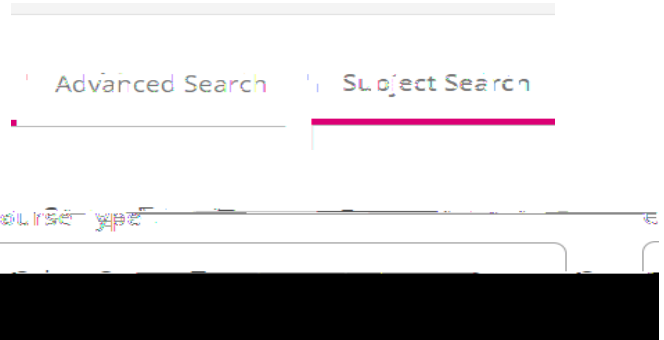




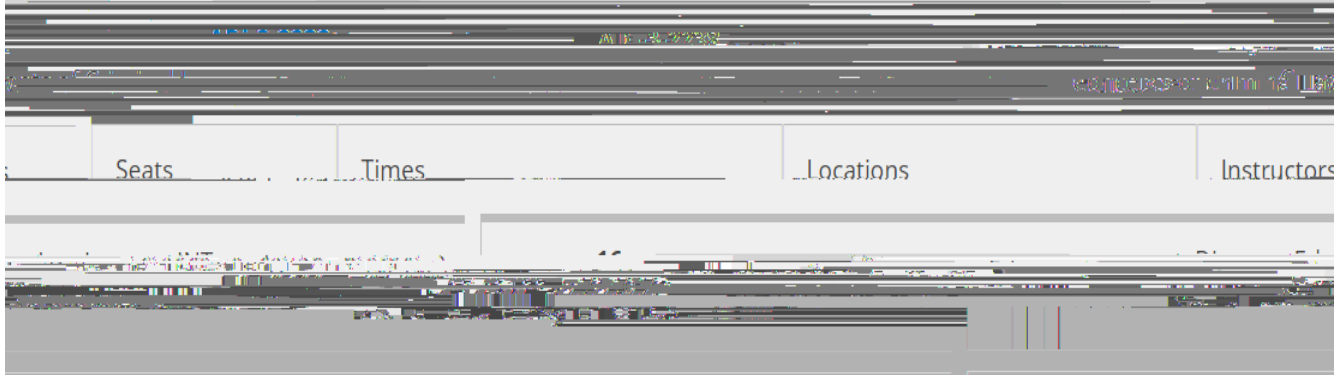
Current situation with PAWS and Low-Cost:
