7. PRESENTATION ON OPEN EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES (OER)/LOW-COST TEXTBOOKS Lisa Storm, Academic OER Coordinator, provided an informative overview on Open Educational Resources/Low-cost Textbooks. The presentation focused on the advantages of OER/Low-Cost Textbooks, state and funding regulations and the impact if the District is not compliant, availability of potential grant funding, how OER/low-cost textbooks support equity for students, and the total student savings (\$1.3M). Lisa also shared results from a study conducted by CSU Channel Islands and survey she administered to students and faculty. Lisa suggested improvements, such as creating and posting a video on PAWS about how to search for zero and low-cost sections using advanced search as well as improvements to the textbook ordering process. In closing, she stated that she is developing a web page with affordable textbook options, hands-on help for faculty, and the development of a flex credit class on OER and Equity.
