Greetings Colleagues -

In the fall of 2015, the Statewide EEO and Diversity Advisory Committee identified nine best practice areas for success in promoting EEO. These nine areas now serve as the "Multiple Methods" for the allocation of the EEO Fund. In order to qualify for EEO Funding for fiscal year 2017 -2018, your district must complete and submit a Multiple Method certification form by June 1, 2017.

The attached memo provides an overview of the Multiple Method allocation model and identifies the certification requirements. Please note that the only change to the Multiple Method allocation model for this year is that districts are now required to certify that they submitted an expenditure/performance report on the use of EEO funds in the prior fiscal year. The annual submission of an expenditure/performance report on the use of EEO funds is already required by title 5.

The Office of the General Counsel has several resources available on its website to assist our districts in the formulation of strong and impactful EEO programs. All Multiple Method forms submitted by districts for the 2015-16 fiscal year are available on our website for your review and convenience at <http://extranet.cccco.edu/Divisions/Legal/EEO.aspx>. As you know, the best practices reported by our colleges last year were highlighted in an "EEO and Diversity Best Practices Handbook."
