1. Hartnell EEO Demographics 2014-15

Terri shared a power point slide of the statewide diversity statistics reported by the Chancellor's Office, as well as Hartnell's numbers, which are reported to the Chancellor's Office each fall (she shared fall 2014). Different on the statewide slide is that "underrepresented groups" does not include Asian, whereas our reports will include Asian as a category of underrepresented groups. Our total workforce hasn't changed much in the last two years. The graphs show that the ethnic and gender demographics of our classified work force is similar to that of our students, our administrator/managers is less so, and faculty, both full- and part-time, even less than that. Still, Hartnell's demographics in all of these categories is better than those of the state. These data will be part of what we put in our EEO plan. The group discussed strategic efforts to recruit for diversity.
