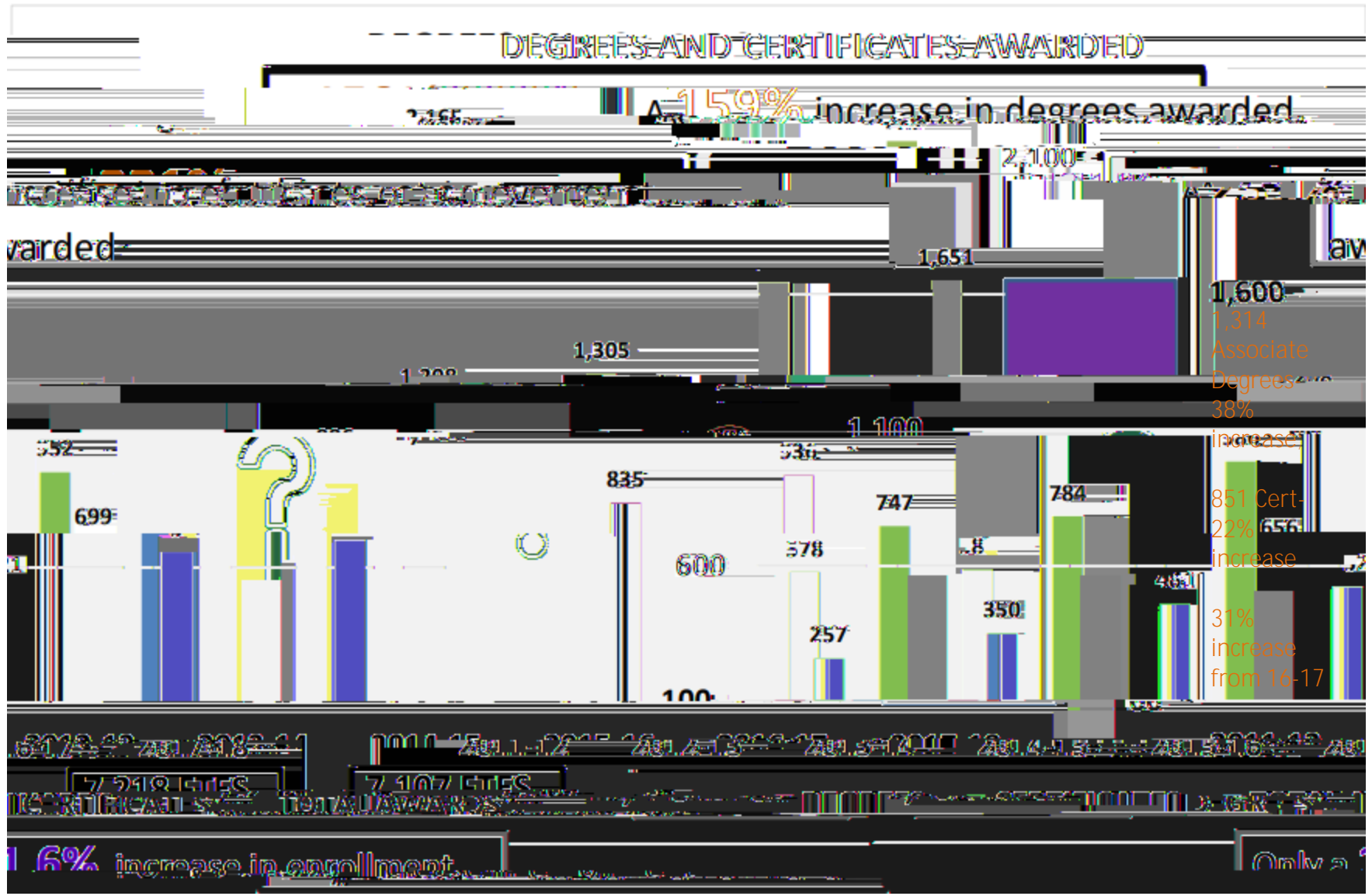

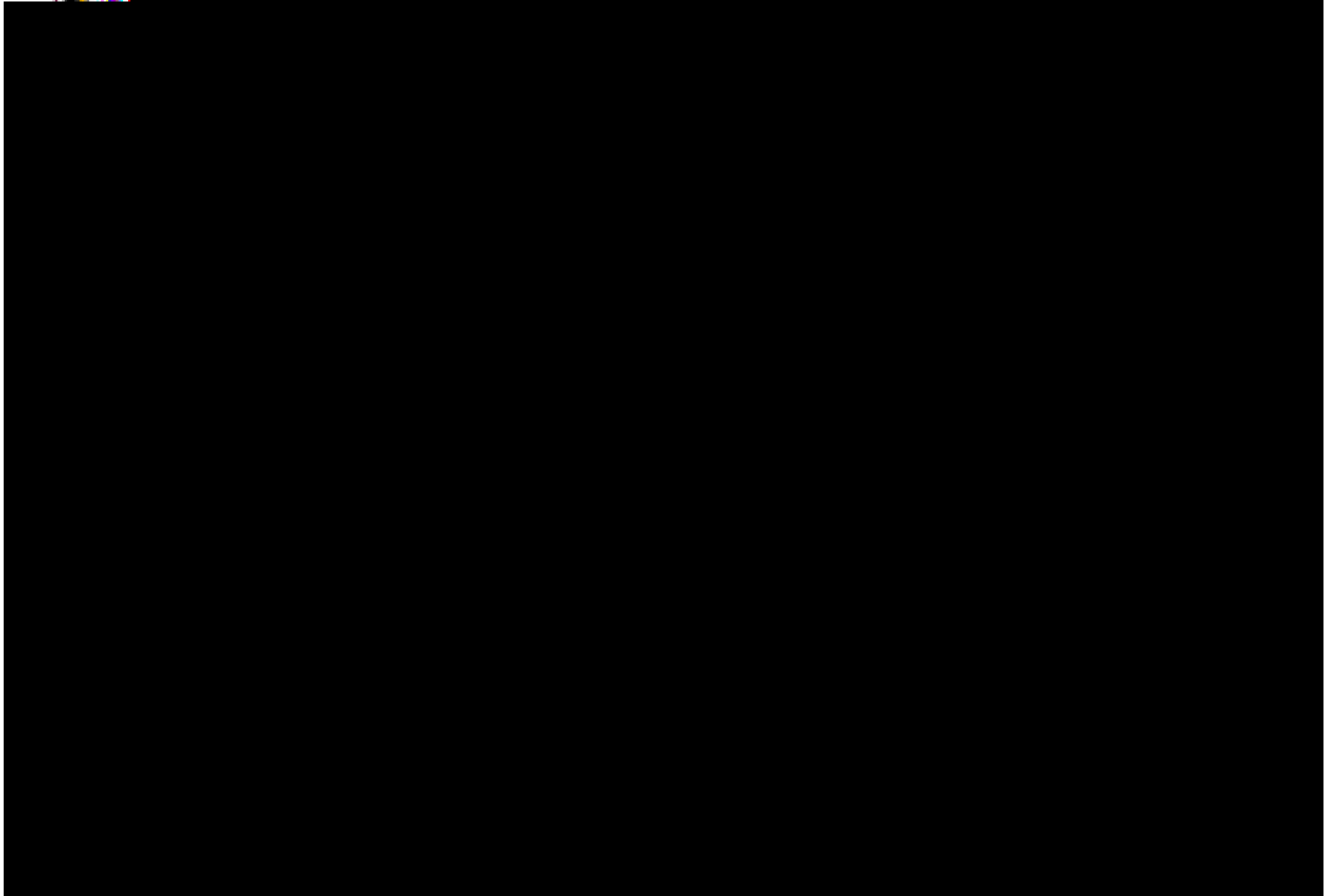






SB 484 is being proposed for the 2019-2020 legislative session that would be auto awarding for all Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT's)



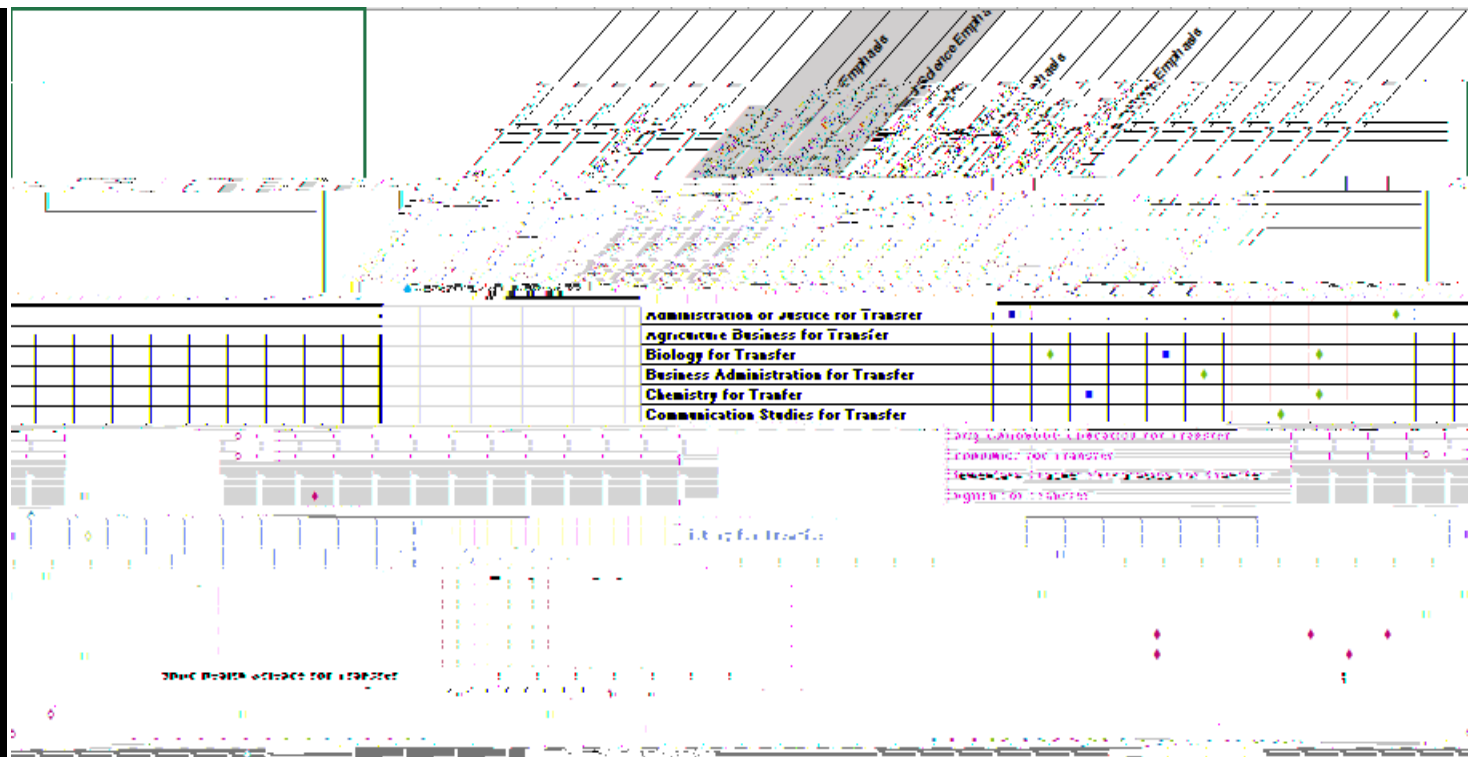

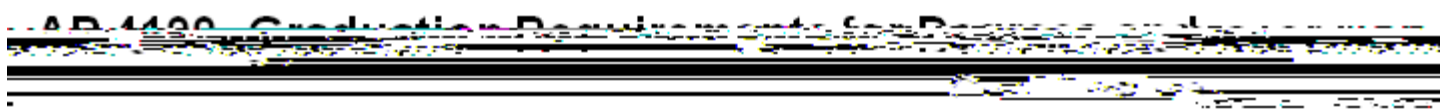
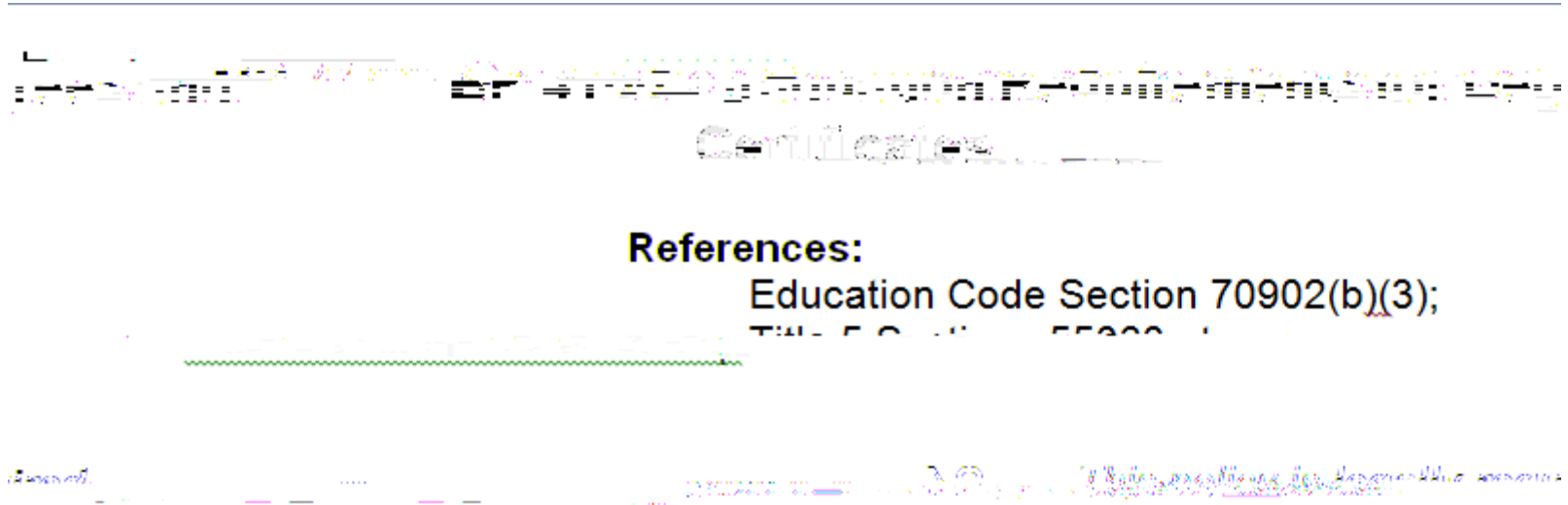
