URGENT: Academic/Progress Probation – Level 2 Update

Dear Student

Per Title 5, Section 58108 Regulations of the California Community College System, you have completed two second consecutive terms (fall/spring semesters) on **academic and/or progress probation** which now has resulted in the loss of two very important enrollment and financial aid services:

Effective the fall 2016 semester (Registration begins on April 21, 2016)*:

- You have lost continuing student priority registration. This means you would register after all continuing and new students who have completed all of the three CORE services (orientation, assessment, educational plan) thereby possibly losing your opportunity for the courses you need to complete your educational goal.

AND

- You are also ineligible for the BOGW Fee Waiver starting in the fall 2016 semester. This means that you will need to pay your enrollment fees by the stated deadlines for fall 2016 to stay enrolled.

In addition, students who have completed over 100-units (excluding non-degree applicable, ESL courses, and high-unit majors that are over 60 units) will also lose continuing student priority registration (but will not lose the BOGW Fee Waiver for the 100 unit limit).

**Please note that foster youth and former foster youth (age 24 years and younger) are not subject to loss of priority registration for the BOGW Fee Waiver under these regulations.*

How to regain eligibility for the Enrollment Priorities:

- Review the appeal criteria, complete, and submit a Hartnell College Loss of Enrollment Priority and/or BOGW Fee Waiver Appeal form by **Thursday, March 17, 2016** to the Admissions & Records/Financial Aid Office. No late appeal forms will be accepted.

How to regain eligibility for the BOGW Fee Waiver:

If you lose eligibility for the BOG Fee Waiver, there are a few ways that you can have it reinstated:

- Review the appeal criteria, complete, and submit a Hartnell College Loss of Enrollment Priority and/or BOGW Fee Waiver Appeal form by **Thursday, March 17, 2016** to the Admissions & Records/Financial Aid Office.

OR

Do not enroll at Hartnell College for two consecutive primary terms (Fall/Spring).
