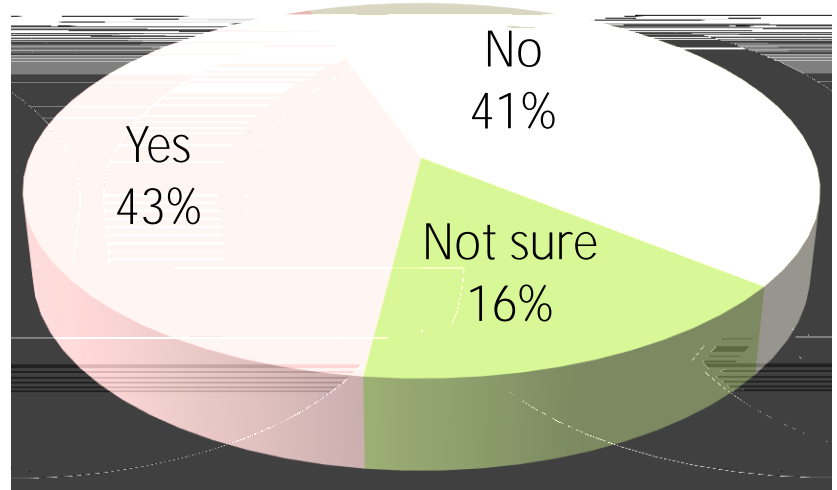
- Recent studies found that 1 in 5 students within the California State University system does not have access to enough food, while 1 in 10 is homeless.
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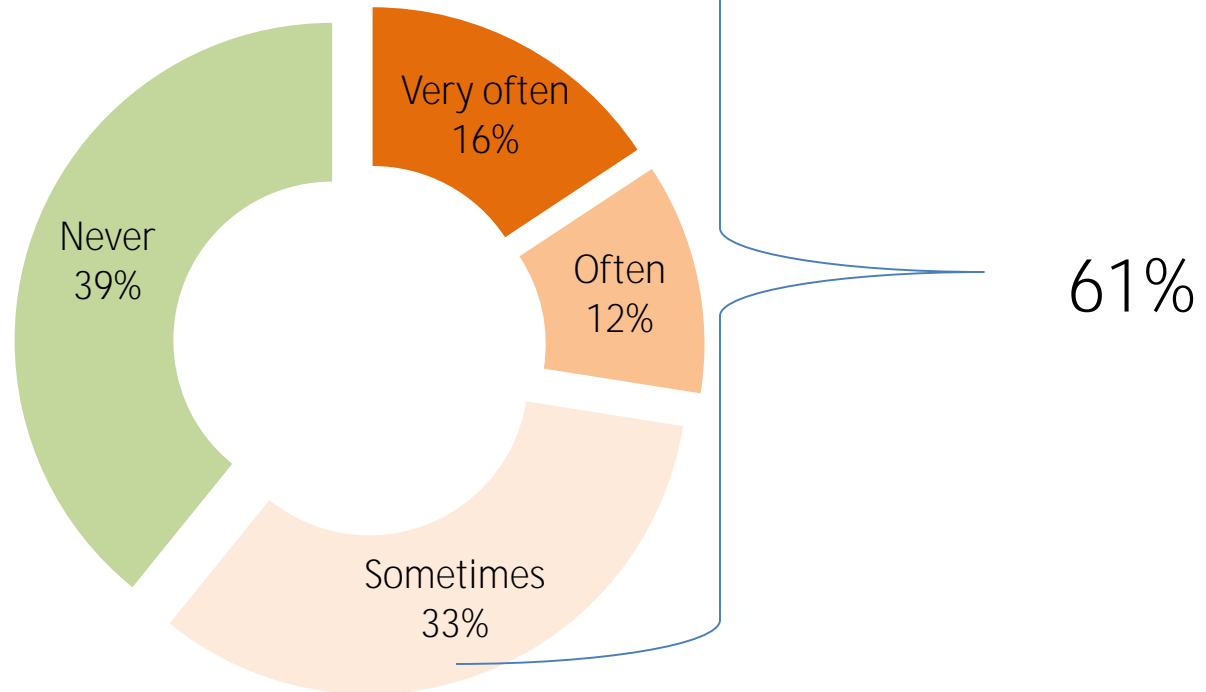
Hartnell College's Associated Student Government defines food insecurity as ~~unreliable~~ access to

nutritious food.

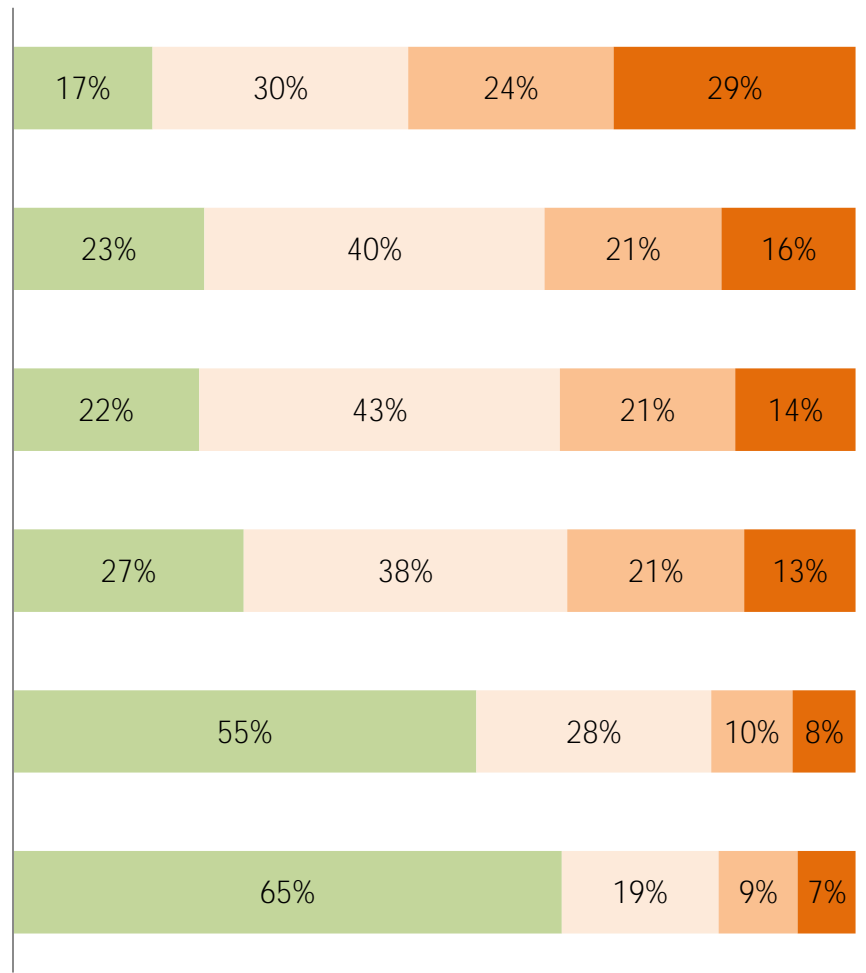




In this semester,

food insecurity?



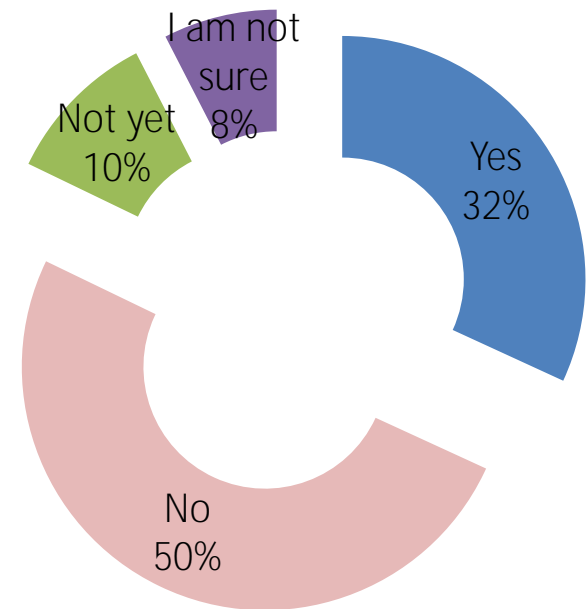
I have accessed food assistance resources





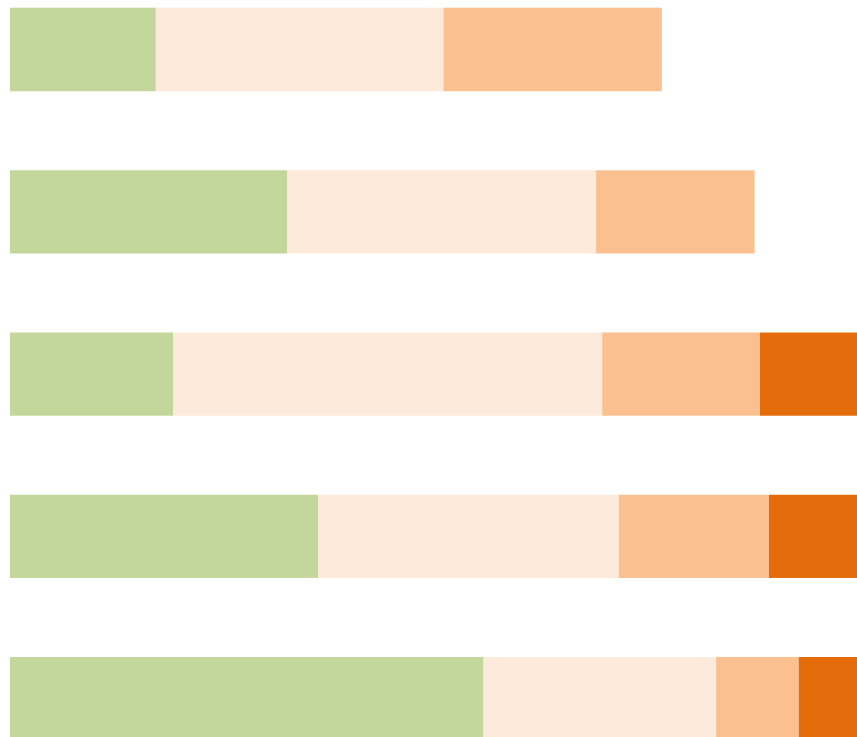
Hartnell College's Associated Student Government defines a well balanced meal as having

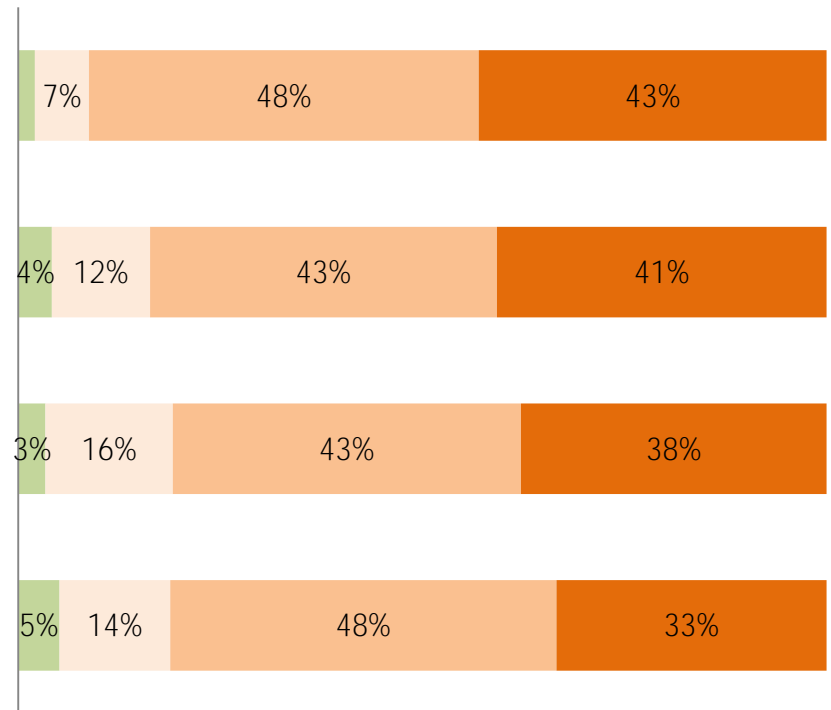
one serving of fruit,

Based on this definition, have you had a well balanced meal in the last 24 hours?







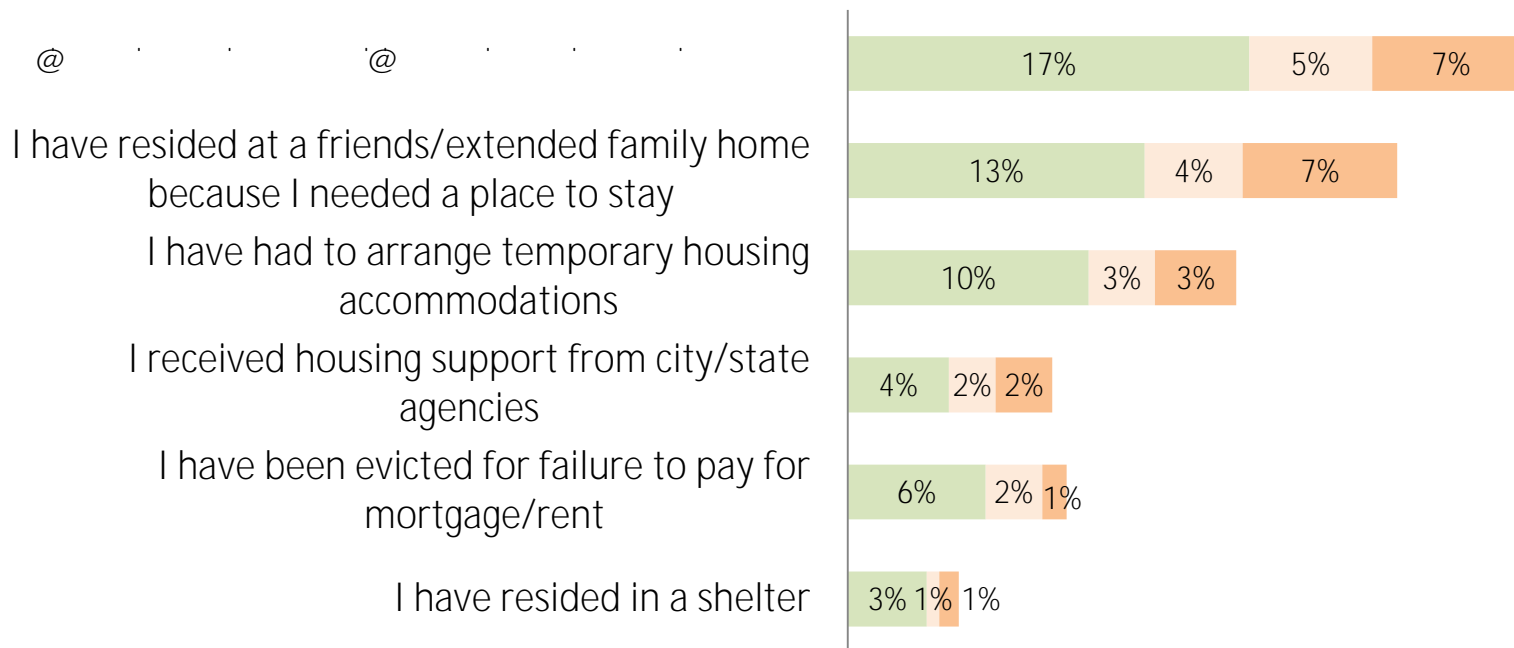
*came back to school because my family of 4 rented a home, but survived on \$100 weekly to buy gas, groceries and diapers. we live in a very expensive community. I often went without eating*



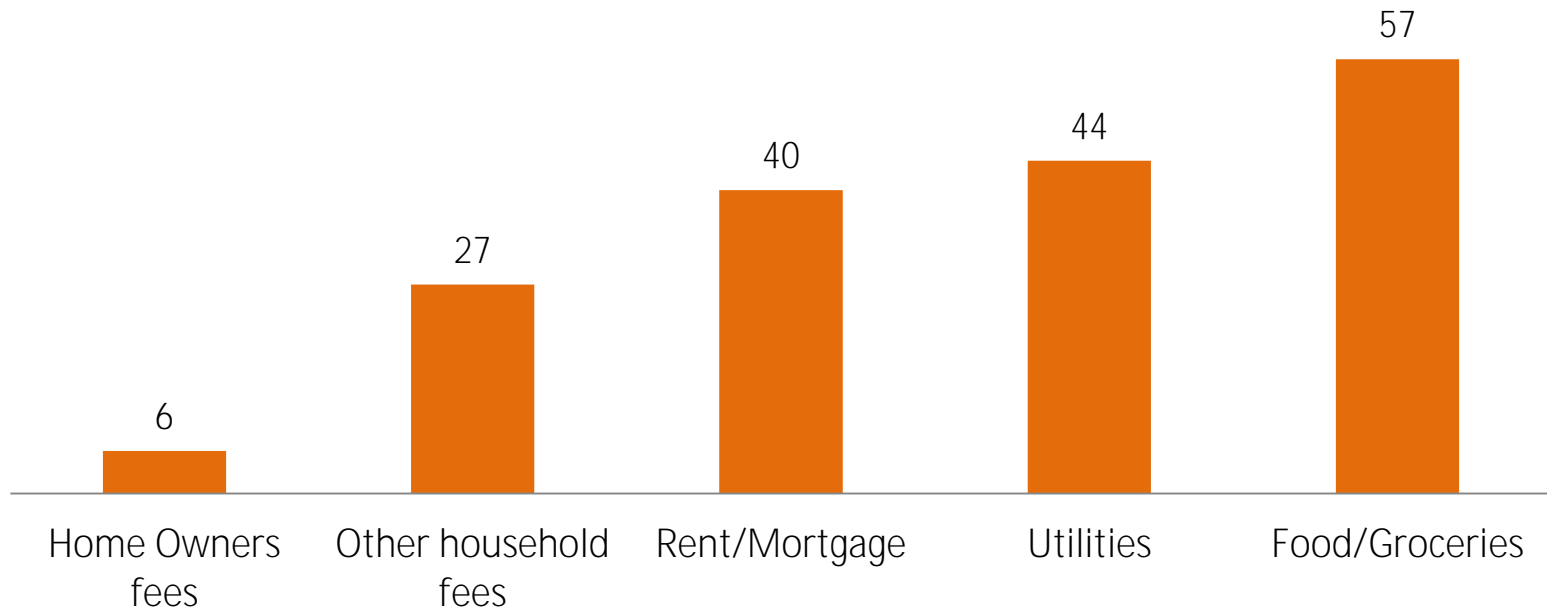


## Frequency of Experience with Housing insecurities events

■ Sometimes   ■ Often   ■ Very Often

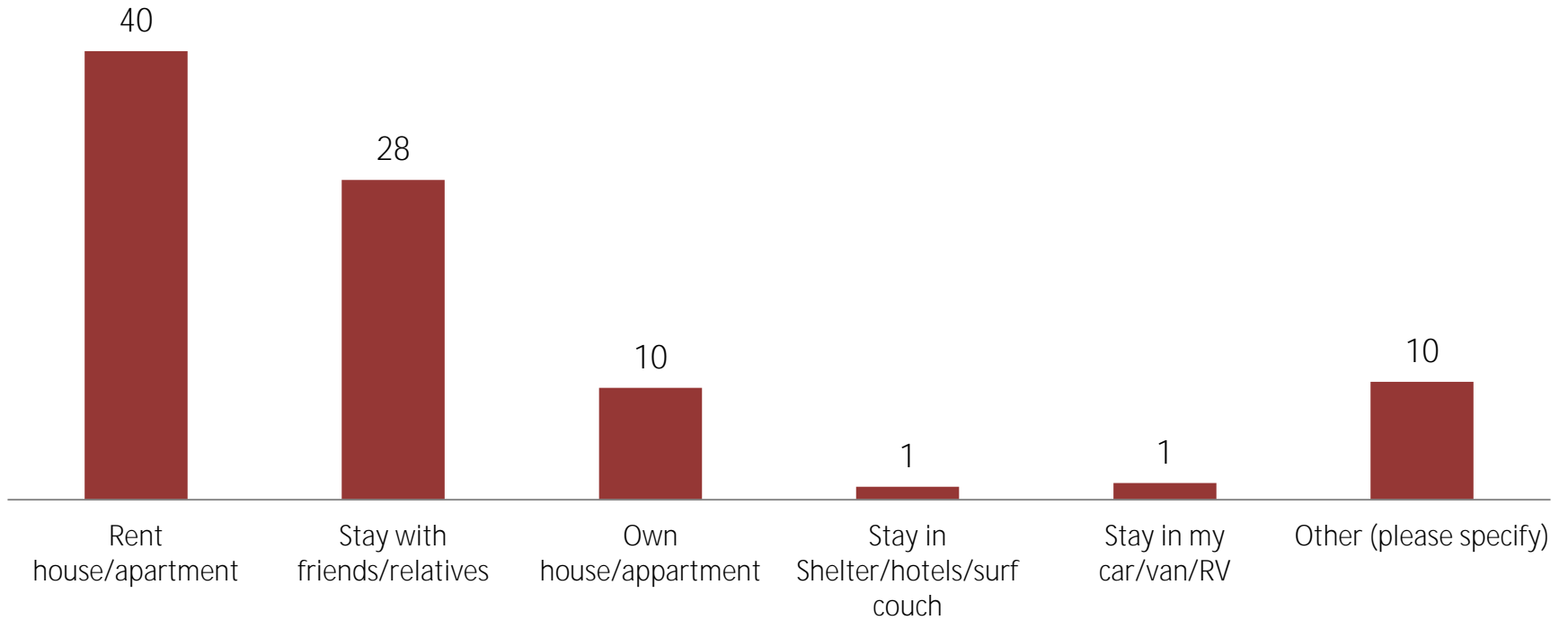


Do you help/support financially with the following - EM/P AMD
