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 Recent studies found that <u>1 in 5 students</u> within the California State University system does not have access to enough food, while 1 in 10 is homeless.










Hartnell College's Associated Student Government defines a well balanced meal as having


one serving of fruit, one serving of vegetables, one serving of dairy, one serving of protein, and one serving of grains.






Do you help/support financially with the following - EM / P AMD -
