- On Thursday, January 11, 2018 we provided all our recent graduates with a tour of the Hartnell Main Campus. During the tour students become familiar with the campus layout, student services and their offices, academic services and their offices, and campus staff.
- All admitted Spring 2018 HEP students were invited to attend a Kick-Off event on Saturday, January 13, 2018. During this event all attendees heard from HEP graduates, participated in a series of team building activities, completed required enrollment forms, and learned about scholarship opportunities. The goal is to create a sense of community prior to the launch of the semester so they can hit the ground running on day one.
- I am pleased to report that we have identified 12 "HEP Ready" students from South County. We worked with Dr. Steve James, Director of Student Services in Greenfield to identify an appropriate location. An instructor has been identified and hired. Classes for the South County Cohort will begin next week on Monday, January 29, 2018.
- HEP Director has been in conversation with Soledad Adult School and Salinas Adult School to provide official HiSET testing in our HEP classroom. Testing in a familiar environment helps ease testing anxiety. More importantly, seating at the adult schools is limited and often not enough to accommodate both our and the community's needs. By holding official testing (for our students exclusively) in our classroom seats will become available for community members.
