Title 5, § 51023.5(a) (Staff)

"The governing board of a community college district shall adopt policies and procedures that provide district and college staff the opportunity to participate effectively in district and college governance."

Staff shall be provided with opportunities to participate in the formulation and development of district and college policies. [that] have or will have a significant effect on staff."

§5123.5 (a)(4)



Legal Basis



Title 5, § 51023.7(Students)

The governing board of a community college district shall adopt policies and procedures that provide students the opportunity to participate effectively in district and college governance. Among other matters, said policies and procedures shall include the following:

- Grading policies
- Codes of student conduct
- Academic disciplinary policies
