



Increased the number of Dual Enrollment offerings from 12 in AY 2017-2018, across 7 school districts, and in 11 different high schools; offering at least one dual enrollment class in each of the public, comprehensive high schools in the Salinas Valley. In addition to English & Administration of Justice pathways, course offerings include counseling classes that focus on College Success & Career/Life planning all of which are UC and/or CSU transferrable level classes. . We are currently serving nearly

Soledad High School, Everett Alvarez, and Alisal High School improved A-G Completion by 11%. Females gained 17-28% percentage points in partnership with Bright Futures. Monthly meetings of school and community educators to discuss best practices and develop plans to increase access to and success in A-G approved courses at high schools across the Salinas Valley. Nearly every public school district is regularly represented at these meetings.

Project also employs the College Promotores model, a "community organizing model" for awareness of college readiness and creation of a college-going culture from parents and youth to the community.
