



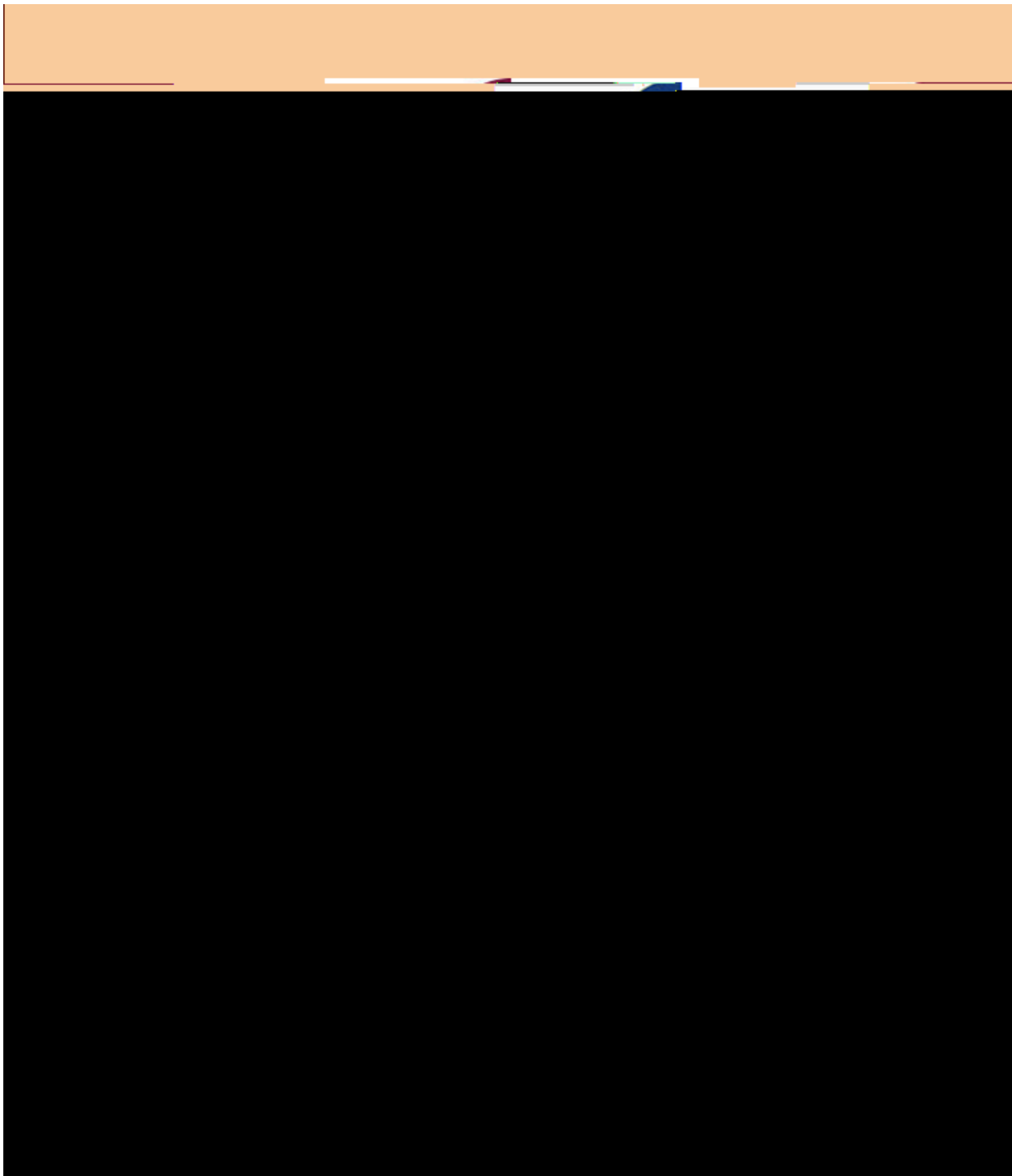

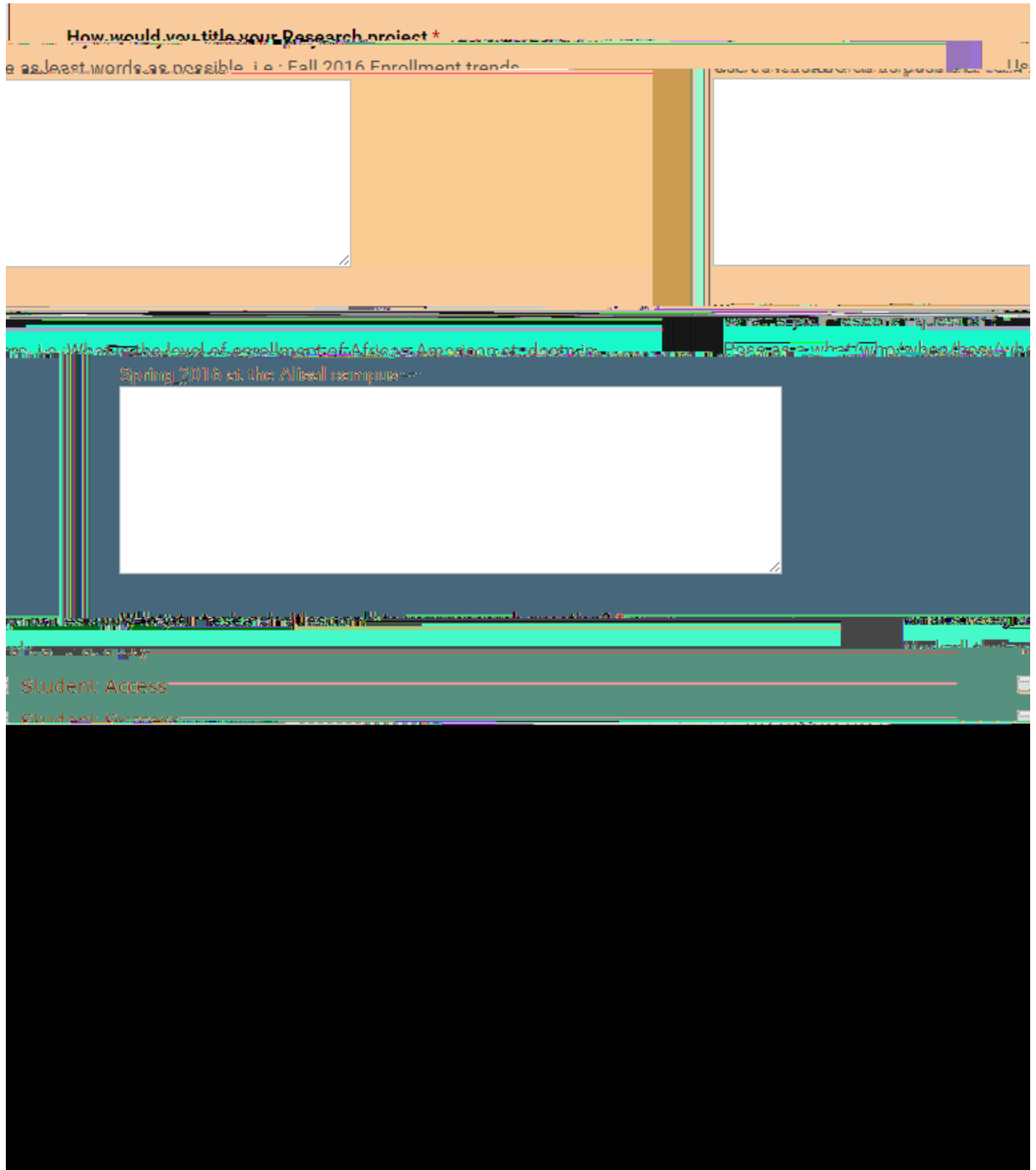
Scoring Research Team (SRT)

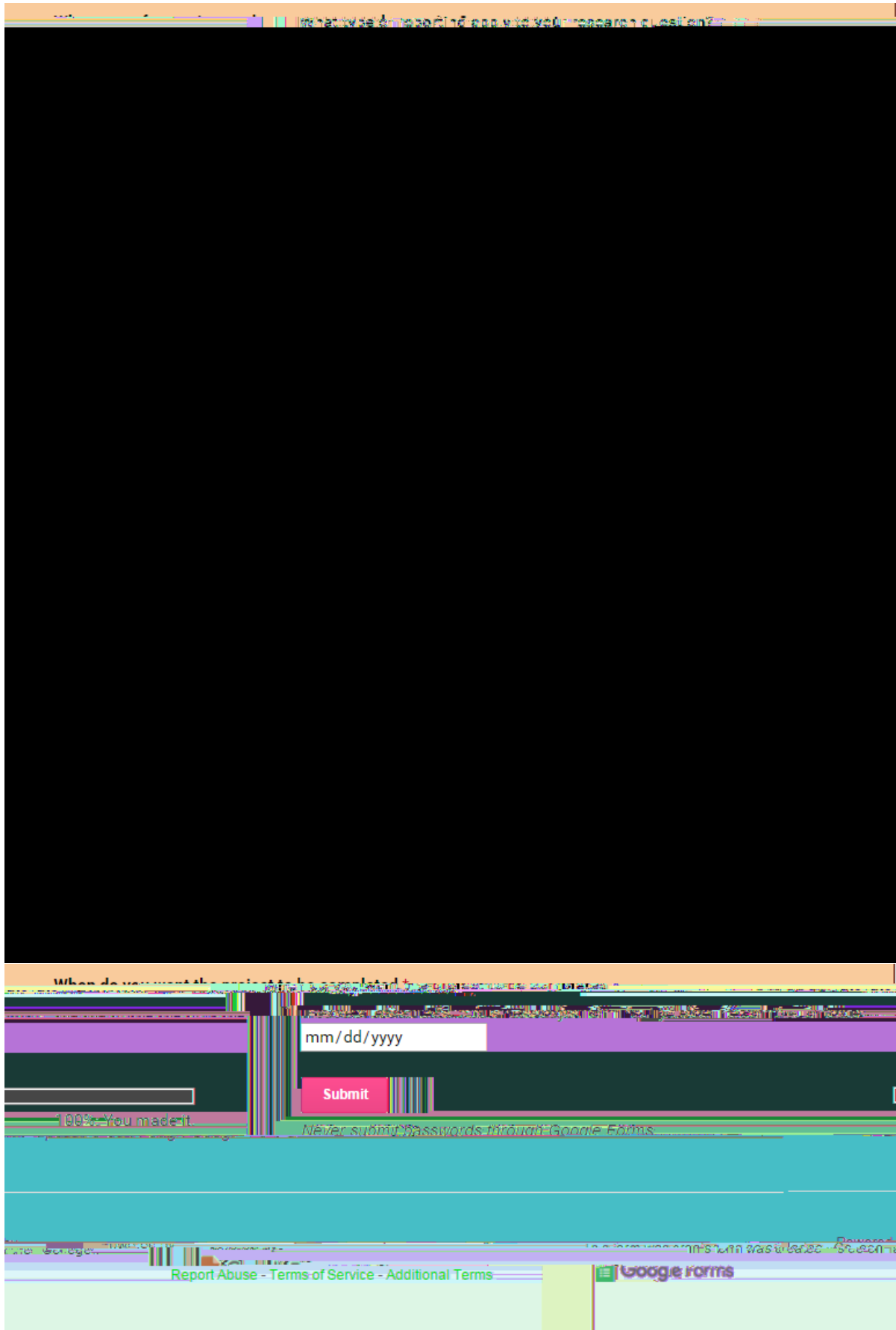
Purpose:

When:	You will receive an email notification from the IR director announcing the need of scoring. It would be based on the flow of projects. You will submit your scoring by Friday 5pm of the week assigned. You will score a max of 5 projects per week. 1 per day.
Why:	We have a large number of projects in queue. In order to prioritize it is important to determine the campus needs.
What to expect:	You will probably have more questions after reviewing the grid, so contact the research director so she can direct your questions.
Note	Do not evaluate projects you are closely involved with. Just mark "unable to score" on the rubric worksheet after the project title.
Confidentiality Agreement	You agree to no disclose any information about the projects, the list or share the ranking you give to projects.

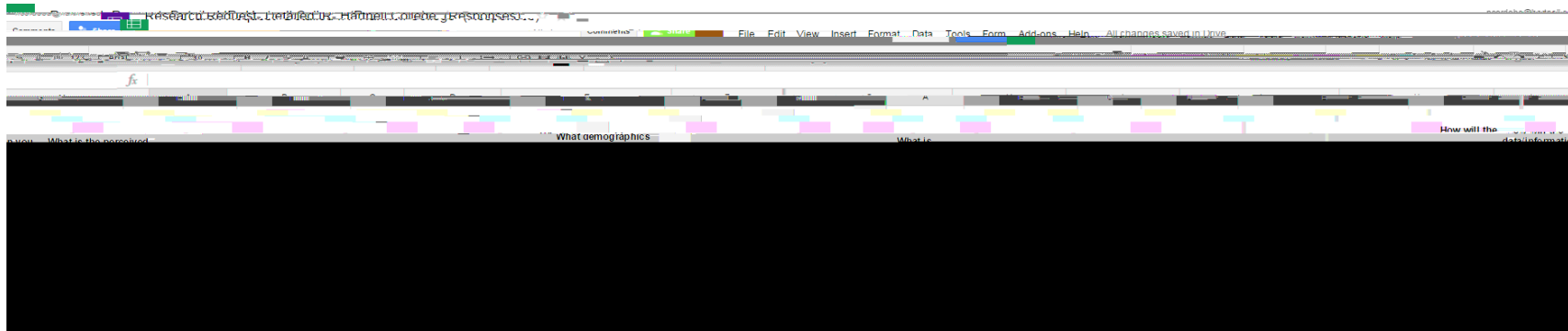






3. How does the Google sheet looks like?
