3. Establishment of CI Process Task Forces

Dr. Lofman spoke about the work that led up to the establishment of five continuous process task forces and he summarized the areas of focus for each:

Safe and Inclusive, Learner-Focused Facilities

Student Career Placement

Student Communication

Student Transfer to 4-Year Institutions

Workflow Efficiency and Digitized Paperwork

In closing, he stated this work has recently started.

4. Student-Centered Funding Formula

Vice President Figueroa provided an overview of the student-centered funding formula. He stated that the funding has three components: base, supplemental, and student success. He stated that the supplemental allocation is based on a point system. He then reviewed how the "point system" would work through an example of 1 FTE, but he cautioned changes to the system are expected. He stated that community colleges would be held harmless for the next three years; that if enrollment dips, the college will be funded at the 2018-19 funding level. This new formula will
