

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) Program

The Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) Program aids exceptionally needy undergraduate students, matriculated in a degree seeking program attending at least half- time. Application for FSEOG is through the completions of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students are exceptionally needy if they have the lowest Expected Family Contributions (EFC of 0). The FSEOG first selection group of recipients includes Federal Pell Grant recipients. They must also meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Complete financial aid file that includes resolution of any flags, verification and any other outstanding data or document
- Not be in default and/or owe an overpayment on a federal grant or loan
- Be matriculated in an undergraduate course of study with no prior Bachelor's degree on file
- Not be incarcerated
- Be maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
